

Background Info

The supervision's workflow idea is based on the 4-eyes principle when creating a new campaign: a campaign administrator will be responsible for creating a specific phishing or e-learning campaign. But he will only be able to start the campaign after a different user (the supervisor) reviewed the campaign and approved it. If the supervisor rejects the campaign a ticket with an expiry date will be created within the campaign for the administrator.

3. If the campaign admin will log in under his "user" role and starts the campaign it will be put on hold, until "supervisor" approves the launch. On this step you can see a new entry created on "Supervision Log". Within the campaign dashboard you will also see a small turning wheel that indicates that the campaign is waiting for approval
