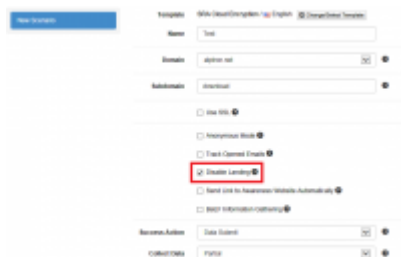


For all scenarios that include a file based attack you will have the option within the scenario settings to disable the landing page. Your attack therefore will only include a mail, without a webpage. The settings can be found here (see screenshot).
