

Setup tutorial for VMware

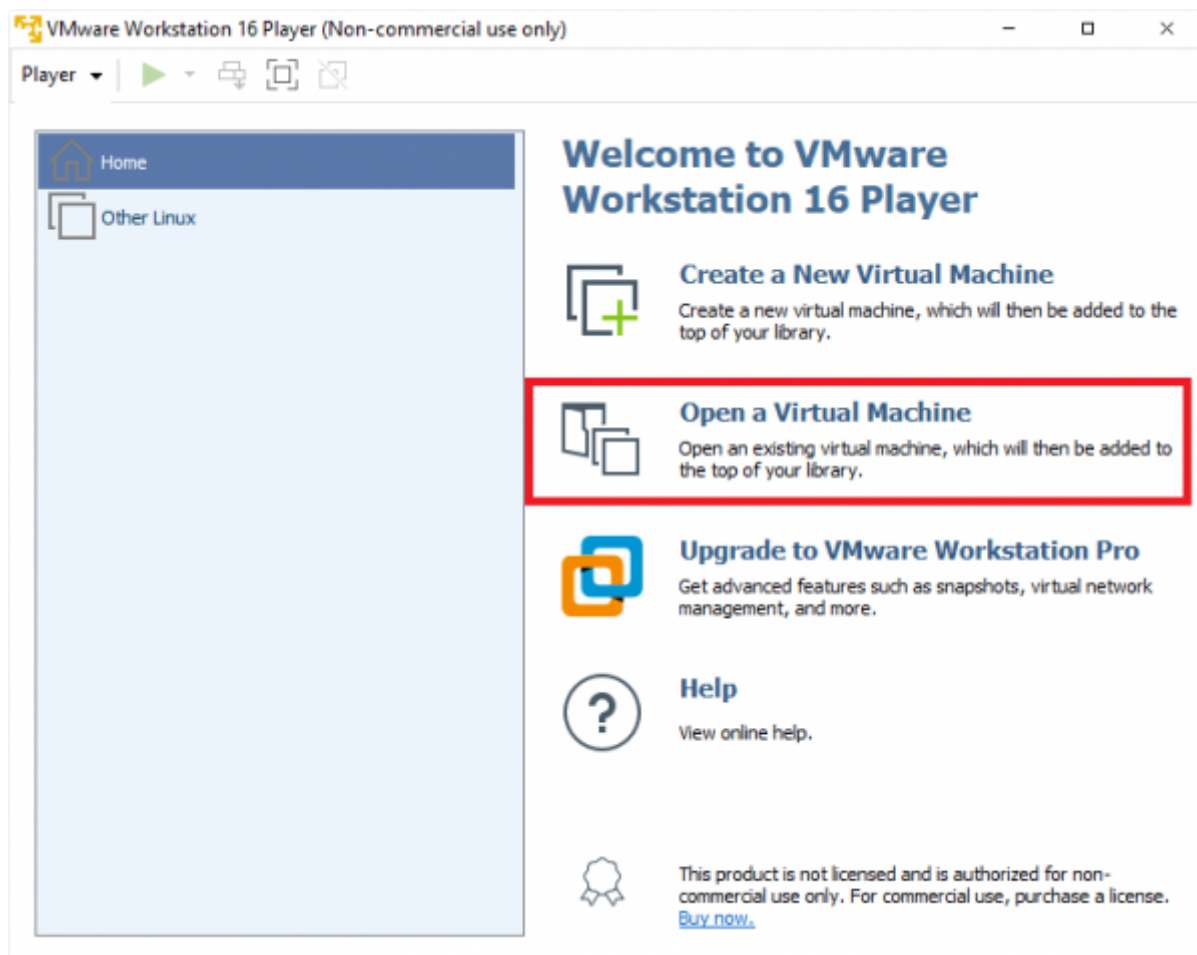
STEP 1:

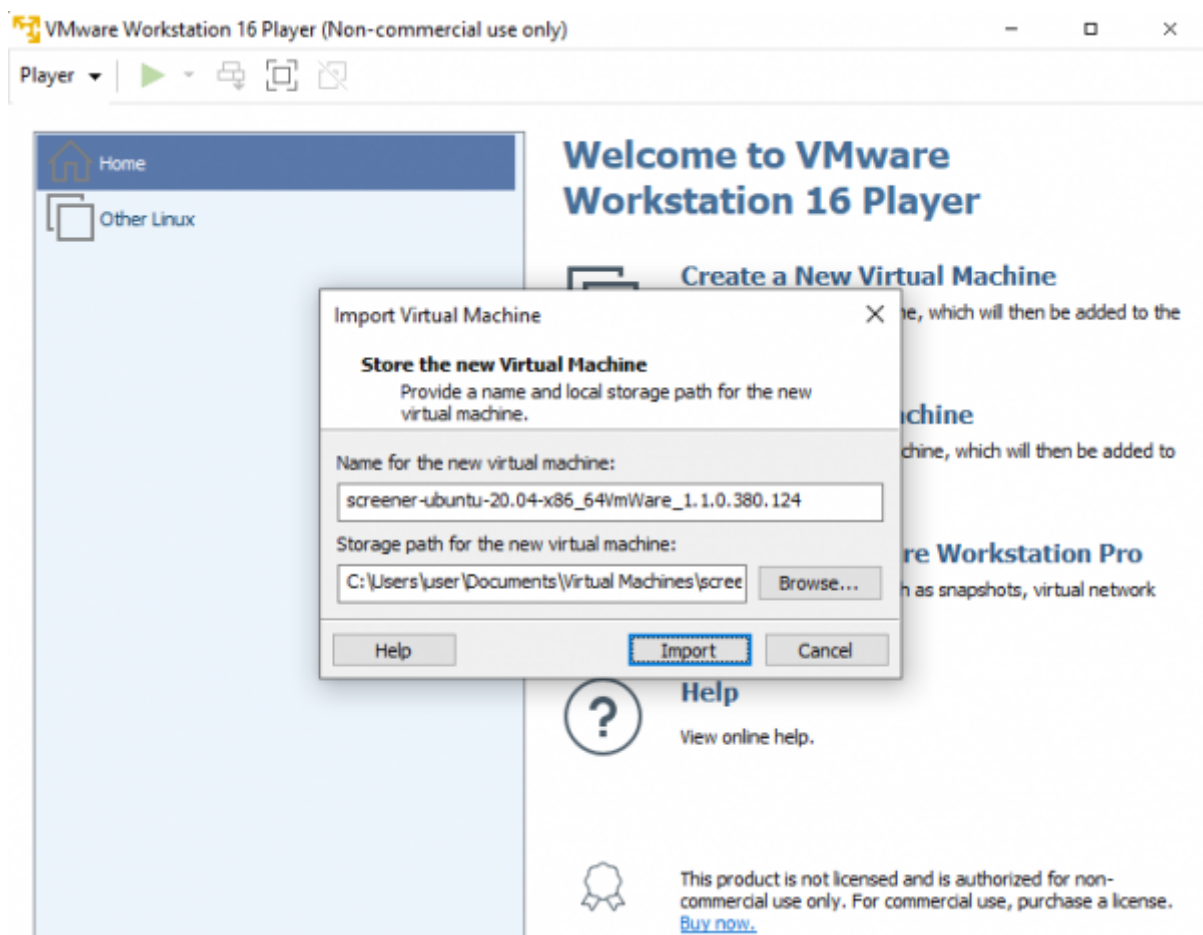
Download the latest free version of VMware here:

<https://www.vmware.com/products/workstation-player.html>.

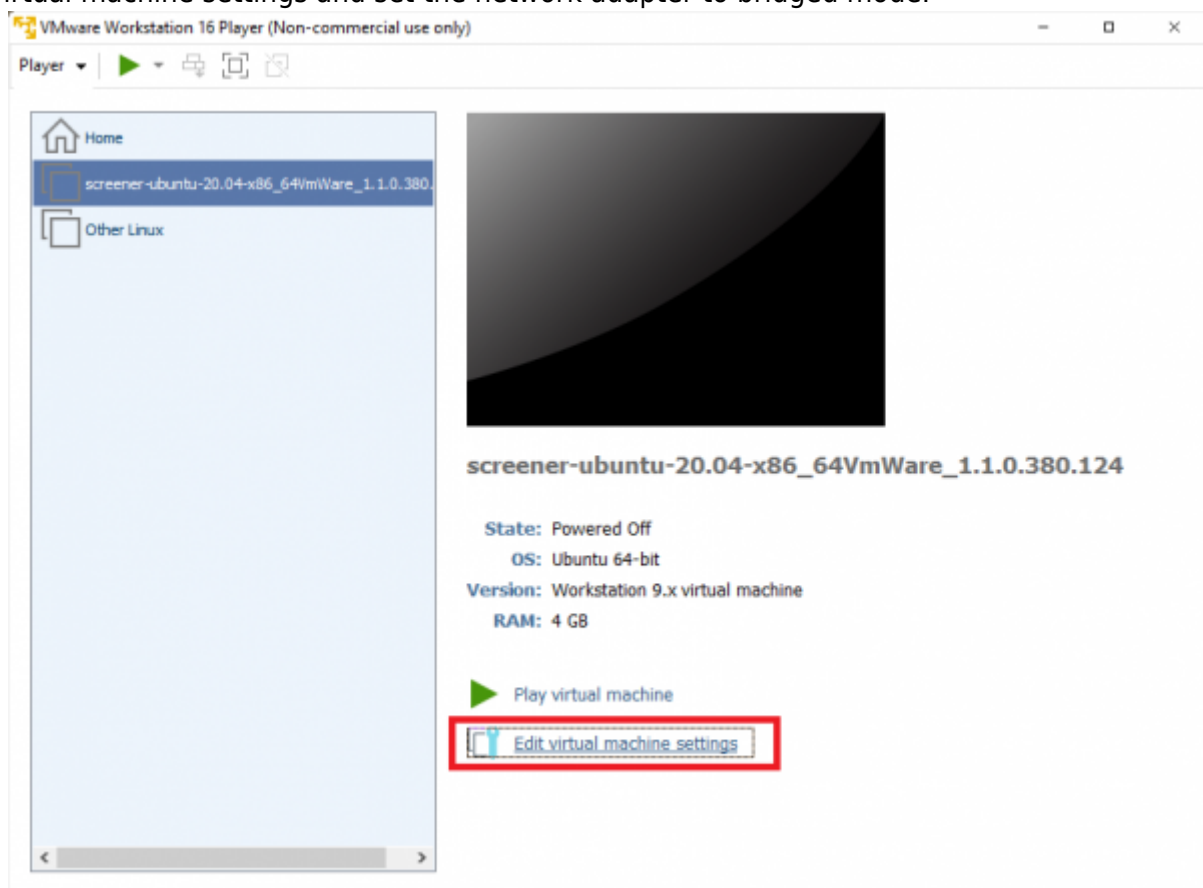
STEP 2:

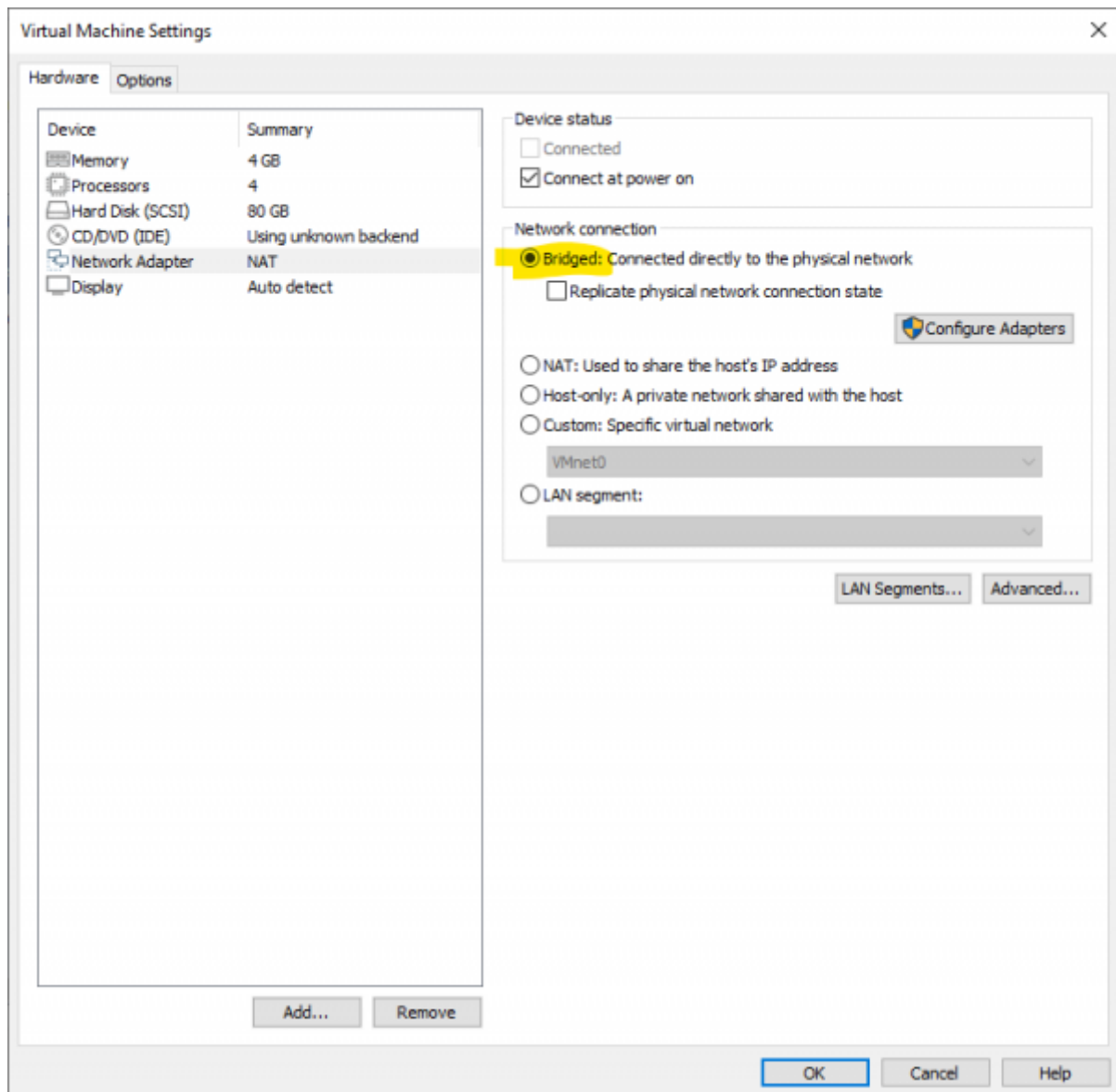
Start the VMware application and open the Screener image file by clicking "Open a Virtual Machine".



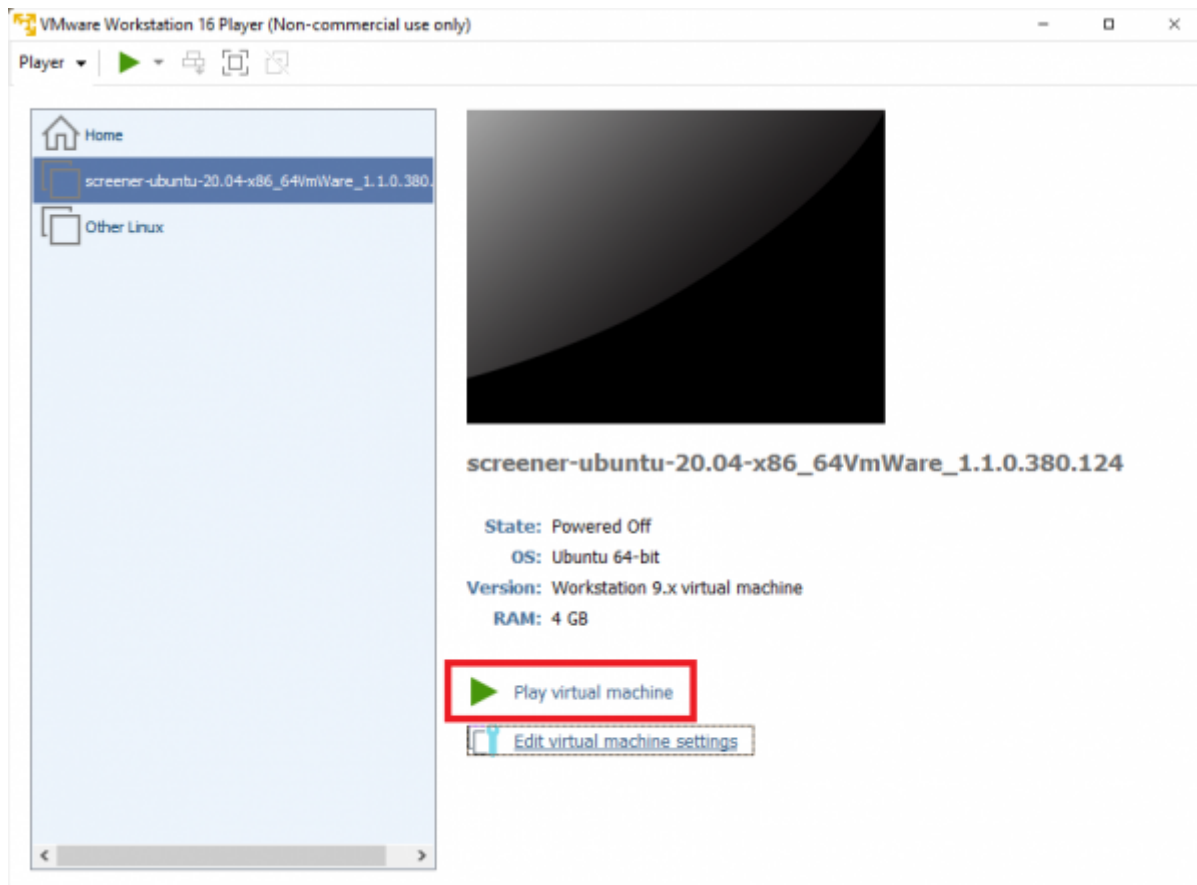
**STEP 3:**

Edit virtual machine settings and set the network adapter to bridged mode.



**STEP 4:**

Start the VM

STEP 7:

As soon as ready, VM terminal displays information for Web UI login, such as network address and user credentials.

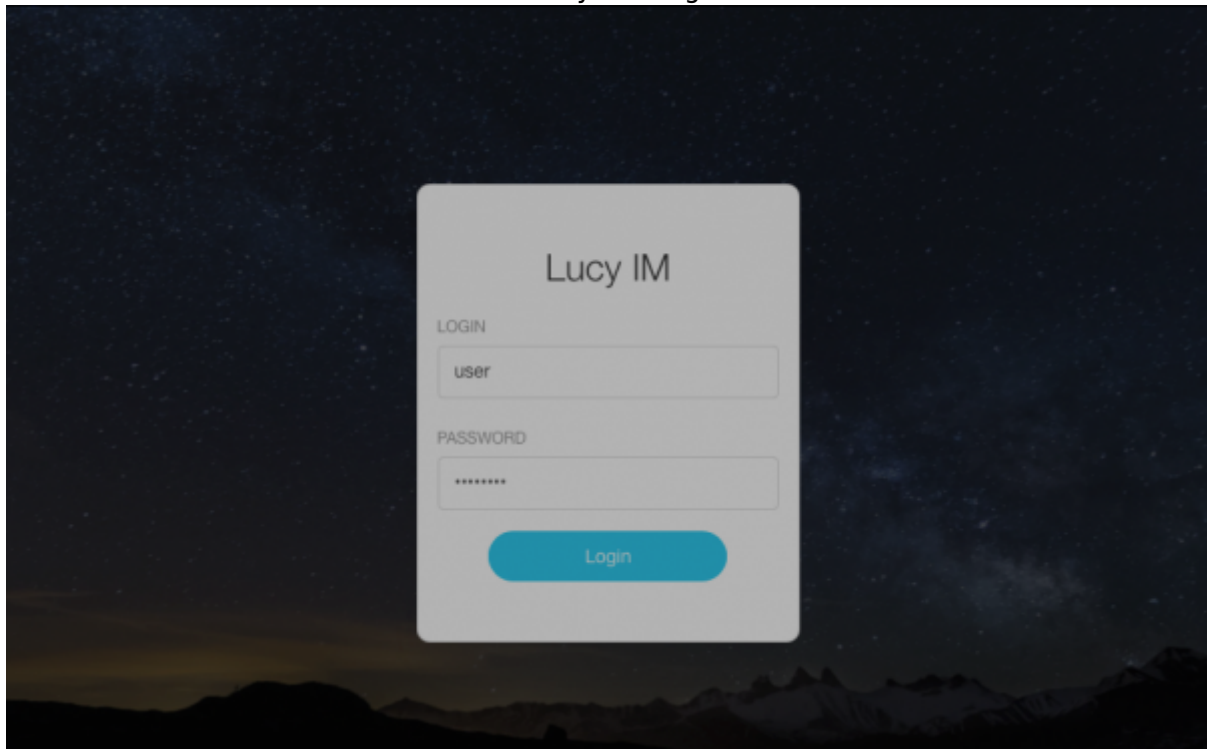

This will enable you to access the web based administration of LUCY
via an official domain name (e.g. lucy.example.com).
Please start the manual setup script under 'domain configuration' to create such a domain entry.
As an alternative you can reach the web based administration of LUCY using a internal domain name.
In the automatic setup LUCY will be given the domain 'phish.local' which can be accessed
from your computer by changing the corresponding records on your nameserver or by modifying
the local hosts file on your workstation (C:\WINDOWS\system32\drivers\etc\hosts in Windows,
/etc/hosts in Mac OS X and Linux).

Enter https://192.168.1.34 or https://example.com (in case you created a host or DNS entry)
in your browser to access the system.
Use the following details to login:
* Login: user
* Password: gzxzbbjx
Press enter to continue...

STEP 8:

Enter the IPv4 into a web browser and do the very first login.



STEP 9:
