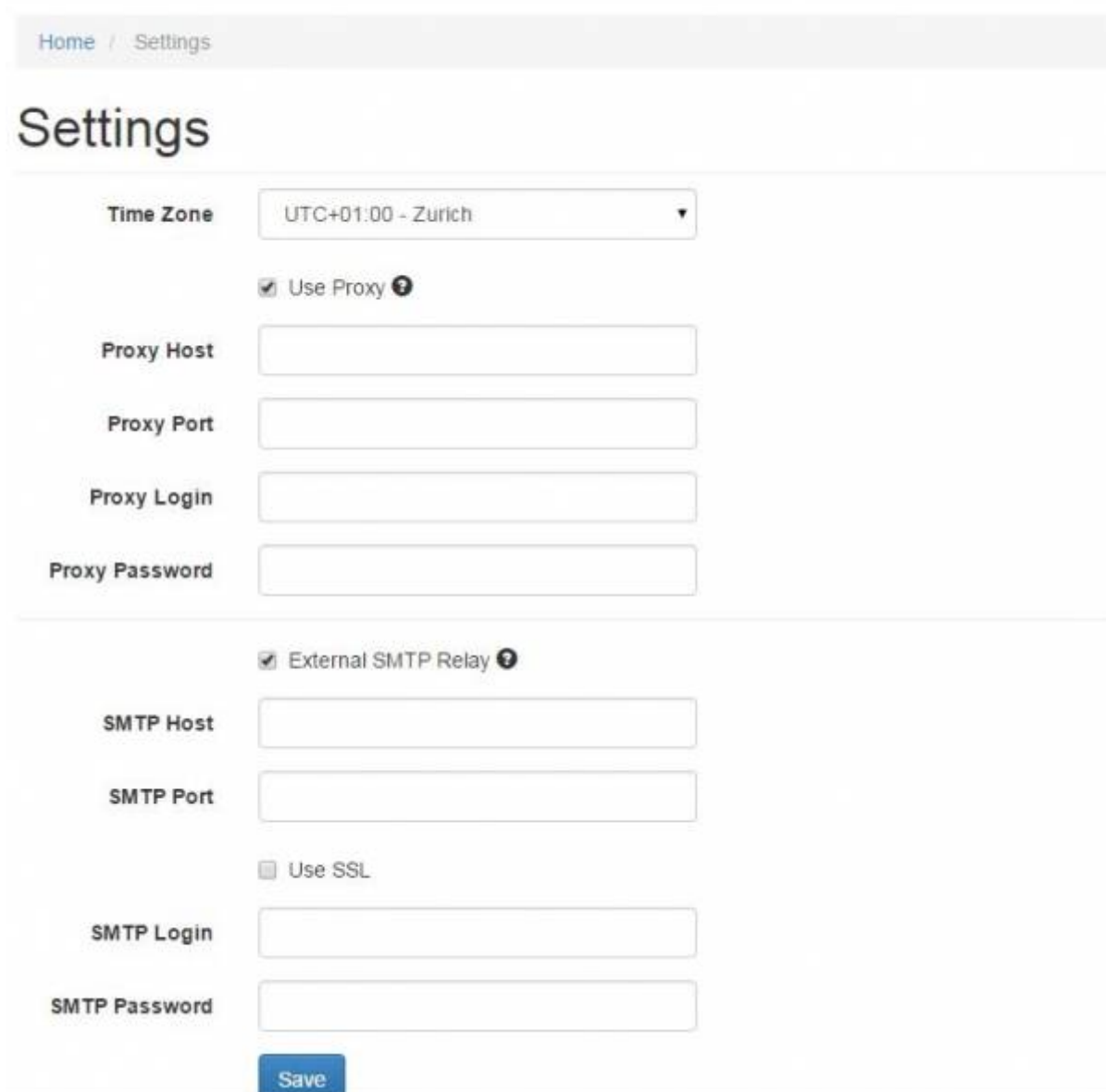


In the Settings Menu, you can specify an external mail server or web proxy. LUCY allows you to specify the server's address and port together with login information (if needed):
