

In the "Advanced Settings" Menu, you can specify a web proxy. You can choose the external mail server in "SMTP servers". Supported Authorization Types are: LOGIN and PLAIN mechanisms over SSL and SMTP+STARTTLS transports LUCY allows you to specify the server's address and port together with login information (if needed):
